To whom it may concern,

This letter is to confirm that Dr Ata'o allah Mohammad Attallah Altawaiha has designed and organized a clinical teaching programme for the fourth-year medical students of Hashemite University. The programme included 500 students and was conducted from 1 July 2023 to 31 August 2023 at the following hospitals:

- Prince Hamza Hospital, Amman - Jordan
- Al Zarqa New Governmental Hospital, Al-zarqa - Jordan

The clinical teaching programme consisted of daily practical meetings, during which Dr Ata'o allah introduced fourth-year students, who are transitioned from the study of preclinical to clinical health sciences, the basics of primary care, including approach to medical history, physical examination, primary management, and essential communication and interpersonal skills to interact with patients.

Students were divided into groups and taken on clinical rotations to apply the learned knowledge under the supervision of Dr Ata'o allah who was a clinical instructor, and were evaluated afterward.

In addition, Dr Ata'o allah considered the 15th edition of "Macleod's clinical examination textbook" as an essential reference and developed a curriculum, which consisted of:

- 1) General aspects of history taking.
- 2) General aspects of physical examination.
- 3) Physical examination of body systems (cardiovascular, respiratory, gastrointestinal, nervous, renal, endocrine, reproductive, and musculoskeletal systems).
- 4) Doctor-patient interpersonal and communication skills.

Students were asked to use logbooks as a record of all clinical examinations, histories and skills they applied throughout the clinical rotations.





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Dr Ata'o allah has demonstrated a great commitment to interactive teaching approaches, which have led to a pleasant learning environment. Moreover, Dr Ata'o allah's interpersonal skills have had a significant influence on his colleagues, patients, and students. Accordingly, Dr Ata'o allah has proven that he is seeking continuous professional development through this clinical teaching course, which expanded his medical experience and teaching skills.
